Ran 184' of 7" 23# seamless J-55 and 2794' of 7" 20# seamless J-55 for total of 2978' and set at 2982'. Cemented with 497 sacks of 3% gel, 85 sacks of Signalite and 200 sacks of Neat. Circulated 250 sacks. Pipe and casing tested on April 4, 1952, with 1300 psi for 30 minutes. Both held.
