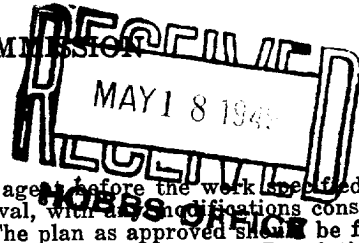

## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

This well was drilled to 11,045' and is making one barrel or less of oil. The 5 1/2" production string was set at 11,020'. We propose to pull as much of the 5 1/2" casing as possible, plug back and run 7" casing to approximately 4,000', and complete as an oil well in the horizon at approximately 3,800'. If this horizon is unproductive, we propose to perforate the Yates gas section at slightly below 3,100'. Seventy-five sack cement plug on bottom and a 75 sack cement plug at approximately 4,100'.
