FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

We propose to deepen this well approximately 50 feet, run a radioactive survey and a 5-1/2 inch M-80 17# Hydrill liner will be cemented to blank off the 141 feet of open hole. Selective perforation will be made from the radioactive log to test for oil production. In event no further production is obtained from deepening, then the pipe will be perforated in the Seven Rivers or Yates formation for gas production.
