DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Pulled tbg. and packer. Ran 3003' of 2" SUE tubing. Before fracing, tanioca gel was spotted in the bottom 10' of the open hole. The open hole, 3710' - 3851', was fraced with 5000 gals. of oil and 10000# of sand down the annulus. The overall injection rate was 9.3 BPM at an average injection pressure of 1100#, including the 140 bbls. of flush oil.
