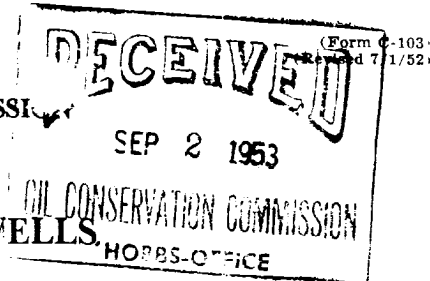

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

June 10 to 15, 1952:

Set retainer at 3557'. Squeezed 3675' to 3780' with 88 sacks 3% and 2 sacks Signalite. Top of cement at 3535'. Shot Yates, 2810'-3070'. with 4 jet shots per foot. Swabbed dry and could not pump fluid into formation at 1700 psi. Shot Yates again with 2 open hole shots per foot and could not pump into formation at 1000 psi. Well shut in.

August 1, to 9, 1953:

Shot Yates, 2810'-3070', with 2 1/2 quarts of nitro per foot-650 gals. Well swabbed dry with no show of gas or oil.

Well dead before and after workover.
