This form shall be filled out by the owner, OPERATOR with the District Office of the Oil Conservation Commission, covering each unit from which oil or gas is produced. A separate form shall be used for each transporter authorized to transport oil or gas from the unit. If said certificate has been approved by the Oil Conservation Commission, a copy of the same shall be forwarded to the transporter, one copy returned to the owner, and the original retained by the Oil Conservation Commission.

A new certificate shall be required in case of change in operating ownership and each change in the ownership shall be treated as a temporary change in the transporter for one production period. For each change in ownership for one production period, the operator shall file a new certificate with the Oil Conservation Commission District Office. The transporter shall be authorized by certificate on file with the Commission to transport oil or gas from the unit of oil or gas to be moved by the transporter to the unit of oil or gas to which the unit and the name of such temporary transporter shall be indicated. If the unit also be authorized such temporary transporter, the transporter shall not be authorized to move more oil or gas than the unit is authorized to produce.

This certificate shall be valid and approved by the Oil Conservation Commission for the period of one production period and authorization to transport oil or gas from the unit shall remain in full force and effect until

1. A new certificate is filed with the Commission;
2. The unit is no longer producing;
3. The unit is no longer authorized by the Commission.

If any of the above conditions of the Oil Conservation Commission have not been complied with, the certificate shall be voided, explain fully under the heading "Remarks".

In all cases where a unit is filed for a change in operating ownership or a new transporter is authorized to move oil or gas, show under "REMARKS" the name of the new owner and the transporter previously authorized to transport oil or gas.

A separate form shall be filled out for each producing unit as designated by the Oil Conservation Commission.
