DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " tubing was pulled, flow valves removed and tubing was acidized to to remove scale. The 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " tubing was run back into the hole and bottomed at 3448' as follows:

at 2268 set 2-1/8" perforations
 at 2459 " 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ x 1" seating device
 at 3063 " 1 - 1/8" perforation
 at 3255 " 1 - 1/8" "
 at 3448 " bottom of tubing

Witnessed by One inch tubing was run into the well and seated at 2459 in seating device.
