Acidized well with 5,000 gallons Halliburton 15% non-emulsifying acid from 3,860-3,900 feet. No results.

Shot with 300 quarts nitro-glycerine from 3,790-3,940 feet.  
Results: Increased fluid in hole from zero to 2,600 feet.  
Cleaned out hole with cable tools.
