Detailed account of work done, nature and quantity of materials used and results obtained.

This well was drilled to 1427' in Anhydrite. Ran 46.5 joints, 1418.30', 8 5/8" OD 21# casing set at 1427' and cemented with 600 sacks 4% gel plus 200 sacks neat on bottom. Circulated out 50 sacks. Plugged down at 6:30 a.m., 10-1-55. After allowing cement to set for 48 hours, 1000# pressure was applied with all valves closed during a 30-minute interval with no drop in pressure. Test was made prior to and after drilling plug. Cement was circulated to the surface behind the 8 5/8" casing.
