South-Eunice Pool Lea County.

The dates of this work were as follows: November 9 through November 17, 1951

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The Cities Service Oil Company's Closson-A #3 Well was plugged back from a previous PB total depth of 3680' to a current total PB depth of 3520'.

The tubing was pulled, Lane-wells log run and Halliburton retainer set at 3525'. The perforations from 3530' to 3590' were squeezed with 50 sacks of cement, 27 sacks were squeezed into the formation and 23 sacks were circulated out. The casing was then perforated from 3410' to 3460' with 2 shots per foot and the tubing rerun and well swabbed in.

On a 24 hour potential the well produced 5700 MCF of gas per day and 6 bbls of water on 1" choke with a tubing pressure of 280# and casing pressure of 300#.
