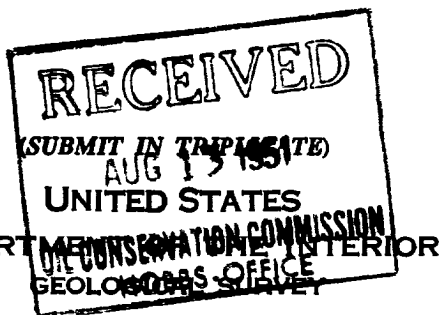

DETAILS OF WORK

It is recommended that Well No. 5 on the Closson-3 Federal Lease (No. 030132-3) be plugged and abandoned after all reclaimable casing is pulled. Well No. 5 on the Closson-3 Lease died due to water encroachment and artificial lift methods failed to produce anything but water. Since other wells in the field had successfully been recompleted as gas wells by plugging off the water and perforating the upper part of the Seven Rivers producing horizon it was believed that this well might possibly be recompleted as a gas well even though it was an edge pool well. All attempts to find oil or gas in the upper Seven Rivers failed and the record of the work over is as tabulated on an attached sheet.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
