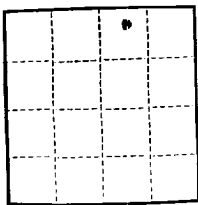

DETAILS OF WORK

Cloessen "B" No. 4 was drilled to 3810'. Killed the well with mud, pulled 2" tubing. Cleaned paraffin from tubing. Ran 2" tubing to 3707', circulated hole with mud, spotted 40 sacks cement on bottom, filled up to 3387', pulled tubing. Shot 5" casing at 2900' but it was not free. Shot again at 2700' but it was not free. Shot third time at 2500' and worked pipe free. Pulled 22 joints (2583.08') of 5" casing. Ran 2" tubing to 2590', spotted 25 sacks. Pulled tubing up to 1564', spotted 40 sacks of cement at base of 2-5/8" casing (1544'). Pulled tubing. Took strain on 2-5/8" casing but it was not free. Ran 20 sacks of cement plug in top of 2-5/8" casing. Plugging began 5-8-57 and was completed 5-14-57. The cellar has been filled, the location cleaned up and a 4'-4" pipe was left for a marker at the abandoned location. Plugging operations were supervised by Mr. E. V. Hodson, 121 South Turk Street, Hobbs, New Mexico (Lea County Casing Pullers) and Mr. C. H. Macnamis, Production Foreman and R. E. Woodruff, Assistant Production Foreman for Cities Service Oil Company.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
