DETAILS OF WORK

This well was spudded at 3:30 A.M., June 3, 1956. It was drilled to 1510' in a hydrite. Ran 49 1/3 joints (1494.08') & 5/8" CD 24# 8R J-55 SS Cag. set at 1509' and cemented with 600 sack 4% gel plus 300 sacks neat. Cement circulated. Plug was down at 8:15 P.M., June 6, 1956. Cement was allowed to set 48 hours before testing for shut-off. Prior to drilling plug, 800 pounds pressure was applied with all valves closed during a 30 minute interval with no drop in pressure. After drilling plug, 600 pounds pressure was applied during a 30 minute interval with no drop in pressure. Drilling resumed.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
