Gentlemen:

We request the Commission grant us a Non-Standard location for a gas well in order that we might abandon our Lamar Lunt No. 1, 660' from south and east lines of Section 20, and transfer the gas allowable for the Southeast Quarter of Section 20 to our plugged back Lamar Lunt B-1 330' from South and East line of Section 20.

The facts concerning the request are as follows:

1. We commensed our Lener Lant No. 1, June 2nd, 1950, and suplated September 11, 1950. The drilling contractor had a bad fishing jeb at 3618, and comented hole back through the Tates formation twice in sidetracking efforts. The hole was drilled to 3800' and plugged back in an attempt to produce gas from the Tates formation. Due to the long period of time that mud, water and cement were on the formation, we have never been able to get the well to produce as it It has always been a marginal well.

2. On March 5, 1957, we commenced our Lamar Lunt B-1, 3304 from south and east lines of Section 20, and completed the well on March 18th, 1957, at a total depth of 3827' as a Queen Oil wall. This cil some has been depleted and we plagged the well beek on February 20, 1959, to a depth of 3400' and perforated the lates Gas sand. The well has a shut-in pressure of 701#S and the volume tested 1,353 HCF e 300#S.

3. By copy of this letter by registered mail, we have requested waivers from Sunray-Mid-Continent, Gulf, Cities Service, and Continental, the offset operators.
