INSTRUCTIONS

This permit shall be filed in the ADJUDICATE with the District Office of the Oil Conservation Commission, covering each unit from which oil or gas is produced. A separate permit shall be filed for each transporter authorized to transport oil or gas from the unit. After said certificate has been approved by the Oil Conservation Commission, one copy shall be forwarded to the transporter, one copy returned to the District Office, and two copies retained by the Oil Conservation Commission.

A new certificate shall be filed to cover each change in operating ownership and each change in the transporter designated to move oil or gas. In the case of a temporary change in the transporter involving less than the allowable production for one proration period, the operator shall file a temporary certificate to notify the Oil Conservation Commission District Office of the transporter authorized by certificate on file with the Commission, by letter, of the estimated amount of oil or gas to be moved by the transporter temporarily designated to move oil or gas from the unit and the name of such temporary transporter. Such temporary transporter shall also be furnished such temporary permit. Such temporary transporter shall not move any more oil or gas than the estimated amount shown on said notice.

This certificate shall not be required and approved by the Oil Conservation Commission shall not be a guarantee for pipeline connection and authorization to transport oil and gas from the property named therein and shall remain in full force and effect until:

- (a) Operating ownership changes
- (b) The transporter is changed or
- (c) The permit is cancelled by the Commission.

If any of the rules and regulations of the Oil Conservation Commission have not been complied with at the same time this report is filed, explain fully under the heading "REMARKS."

In all cases where this certificate is filed to cover a change in operating ownership or a change in the transporter designated to move oil or gas, show under "REMARKS" the previous owner or operator and the transporter previously authorized to move oil or gas from the unit.

A separate certificate shall be filed to cover each producing unit as designated by the Oil Conservation Commission.
