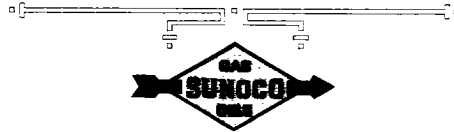

Dear Sir:

Through error we made location for our No. 1, Henry S. Record lease, N 1/2 of Sec. 22, Twp 22-S, R 36-E, Lea County, New Mexico, 466 feet from the North line and 466 feet from the West line of the North half of Sec. 22; however, we are now changing this location so that it will be 660 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the West line of the North half of Sec. 22, so that it will be in the center of 40 acres. We believe that one well located in the center of 40 acres is good spacing, and are in favor of following this rule wherever it is possible to do so.
