FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

The leasehold interest in the above well reverts back to Tide Water Associated Oil Company on May 15, 1953. The well has reached its productive economic limit and we propose to plug and abandon same. All off-set Operators have been notified of the intent to plug and abandon.

We plan to circulate the hole with mud laden fluid and recover approximately 500' of 3 1/2" O.D., 13.5 #/ft. casing. A cement plug will be laid in the 3 1/2" casing from 3435-3600' in the open hole above the point that casing is recovered from 711-800' and a plug at the surface in the 3 1/2" O.D. surface casing. A 4" O.D. steel necker extending 6" above the mean ground level will be cemented at the surface.
