Total depth 3995', ran 5-1/2" casing set at 3990', cemented with 150 sacks, plus 2% Calcium Chloride, Plug Down 5:30 P. M. 7-16-56. Plug was drilled after waiting on cement. Casing was tested with 1,000# for one hour. No loss in pressure, drilling was resumed. Will drill to total depth and Delefrase with 10,000 Gallons and 10,000# Sand.
