Attached is TEXACO Inc. application for dual tubingless completion for the L. R. Kershaw Well No. 7, located 660 feet from the north line and 2310 feet from the west line, Unit C, Section 13, T-20-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico. TEXACO plans to complete this well as a dual tubingless oil completion in the Skaggs (Glorieta) and East Weir (Hlinchry) Pools. It is anticipated that all zones will be oil completions and will flow initially. Approval has been granted previously by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission for these zones in TEXACO Inc. C. 

If, after said twenty-day period, no protest nor request for hearing is received by the Santa Fe office, the application will then be processed.

NOTE: If the proposed multiple completion will result in an unorthodox well location and/or a non-standard proration unit in either or both of the producing zones, then separate application for approval of the same should be filed simultaneously with this application.

NOTE: To be cemented down both strings with 1500 sacks Incor, 4% gel, to obtain turbulent flow. Cement to reach base of salt expected to occur at 2535'.


