

Finished drilling 8-3/4" hole to 3792' at 5:45 AM 10-23-63.

Ran 100 jts. 7-5/8" OD casing set at 3792'. Cemented with 750 sacks 50-50 Pozmix with 4% Gel and 18% salt and 100 sacks Incor cement with 2% Calcium Chloride. Total of 850 sacks. Pumped plug to 3692' at 7:45 AM, 10-24-63 with 1250# maximum pressure. Ran temperature survey. Found top of cement at 2074' or 66% fill. Waited 22-1/4 hrs. Tested casing with 1000#. Held OK.

Started drilling 6-3/4" hole from 3792'.
