Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your request dated July 12, 1956 for permission to flare gas from your Hall State "D" Wells Nos. 1 & 2 located in the E/2 NE/4 of Section 23, Township 22 South, Range 35 East, Jalmat Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

We received a Form C-110 for Well No. 2 dated June 27, 1956 in which Phillips Petroleum Company was shown as connected. Then we received Forms C-110 on both Wells Nos. 1 & 2 dated August 13, 1956 showing Phillips as the gas connection. We would have issued NFO-272 on July 31, 1956 for the flaring of gas from both wells, but with the gas connections as of August 8, 1956 we are hereby dismissing your application.

In the future, please do not submit a Form C-110 on a well showing a gas connection until the well is actually connected to the gas transportation facility.
