APPLICATION OF POGO PRODUCING COMPANY FOR SALT WATER DISPOSAL, LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION**

Under the provisions of Rule 701(B), Pogo Producing Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on November 23, 1993, for permission to complete for salt water disposal its Proximity "31" Federal Well No. 4 located 660 feet from the North line and 2085 feet from the East line (Unit B) of Section 31, Township 22 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

THE DIVISION DIRECTOR FINDS THAT:

- (1) The application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 701(B) of the Division Rules and Regulations;
- (2) Satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators and surface owners have been duly notified;
- (3) The applicant has presented satisfactory evidence that all requirements prescribed in Rule 701 will be met; and
- (4) No objections have been received within the waiting period prescribed by said rule.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

The applicant herein, Pogo Producing Company is hereby authorized to complete its Proximity "31" Federal Well No. 4 located 660 feet from the North line and 2085 feet from the East line (Unit B) of Section 31, Township 22 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, in such manner as to permit the injection of salt water for disposal purposes into the Bell Canyon and Upper Cherry Canyon formations at approximately 4662 feet to 5915 through 2 7/8-inch plastic-lined tubing set in a packer located at approximately 4470 feet.
