TEXACO Inc. respectfully requests administrative approval of an exception to New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Rule 107 (e) for its M. B. Weir "B" Well No. 8. This well is a proposed Single Tubingless Completion in the Skaggs-Glorieta Pool, and is located 660 feet from the South line and 1650 feet from the West line of Section 12, T-20-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

The production casing string will consist of 2-7/8 inch O.D. tubing set at approximately 6880 feet in a 6-3/4 inch hole. Completion will be through perforations from approximately 5280 to 5300 feet in the Glorieta formation. It is anticipated this zone will be slightly corrosive, therefore the entire casing string will be internally plastic coated for corrosion control. Also artificial lift will be required upon completion.

This zone has been approved by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission as a tubingless completion in multiple completions in this area. An instance is Order No. MC-1217, TEXACO Inc., C. E. Weir "A" Well No. 9.

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
