## ***APPLICATION OF SUNDANCE SERVICES, INC. FOR SALT WATER DISPOSAL, LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.***

### **ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION**

Under the provisions of Rule 701(B), Sundance Services, Inc. made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on October 11, 2001, for permission to complete for salt water disposal its Royalty Holdings No. 4 (API No. 30-025-22943) located 660 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the East line (Unit A) of Section 25, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

#### **THE DIVISION DIRECTOR FINDS THAT:**

- (1) The application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 701(B) of the Division Rules and Regulations;
- (2) Satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators and surface owners have been duly notified;
- (3) The applicant has presented satisfactory evidence that all requirements prescribed in Rule 701 will be met; and
- (4) No objections have been received within the waiting period prescribed by said rule.

#### **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

Sundance Services, Inc. is hereby authorized to complete its Royalty Holdings No. 4 (API No. 30-025-22943) located 660 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the East line (Unit A) of Section 25, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the injection of produced water for disposal purposes into the San Andres formation from approximately 4,560 feet to 4,730 feet through 2 7/8 inch plastic-lined tubing set in a packer located at approximately 4,500 feet.




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The operator shall submit monthly reports of the disposal operations on Division Form C-120-A, in accordance with Rule Nos. 706 and 1120 of the Division Rules and Regulations.

The injection authority granted herein shall terminate one year after the effective date of this order if the operator has not commenced injection operations into the subject well, provided however, the Division, upon written request by the operator, may grant an extension thereof for good cause shown.
