Continental Oil Company respectfully requests administrative approval under the provisions of Rule 5 (b) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool of Order No. R-1670 for approval of a 240-acre Non-standard Gas Proration Unit for its SEMU Eumont No. 92 located 660' FAL 1930' FWL of Section 14, T-205, R-37E, Lea County, New Mexico in the Eumont Gas Pool.
