

Introduction

On 17 October 1978, New Mexico Archaeological Services, Inc., (NMAS), Carlsbad, conducted an archaeological reconnaissance on lands administered by the Bureau of Land Management in Lea County, New Mexico. Reconnoitered areas will be impacted by a drill location and access road. This project was administered by Mr. Bob Couch, Amoco Production Company, and Dr. J. Loring Haskell, NMAS. Dr. Haskell undertook the reconnaissance for Amoco Production Company under excellent weather conditions.

Survey Technique

The proposed drill location was examined by walking it in a series of north - south, 20 ft wide, close interval, zigzag transects. As for the access road, it was investigated by traversing it in a 20 ft wide zigzag transect.

Location

Amoco's proposed location will measure 400 x 400 ft and will be situated in the:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 33, T20S, R37E, NMPM, Lea County, NM (BLM)

More specifically, it is situated 2310 ft from the north line and 1980 ft from the west line of:

Section 33, T20S, R37E, NMPM, Lea County, NM (BLM)

The access road will measure 12 x 800 ft and will pass through the:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 33, T20S, R37E, NMPM, Lea County, NM (BLM)
