

Cultural Resources

No archaeological sites, or isolated manifestations, were recorded during this reconnaissance. Contemporary detritus, limited to the area adjacent to the existing road, consists of several beer and pop cans. The absence of quarryable lithic material, potable water, and the general greenness of the country precludes occupation, other than en passant, by technologically simple cultures on the band and tribal levels of socio-cultural integration.

Recommendations

WAS recommends clearance for Continental's Warren Unit #63 and suggests that work-related activities proceed according to existing plans.
