Dear Ms. Ellis:

Reference is made to your request dated November 25, 1986, for an amendment to Division Order No. R-6318. This order dated April 15, 1980, granted Arco an unorthodox oil well location 2123 feet from the South line and 1644 feet from the East line of Section 12, Township 22 South, Range 36 East, NAPM, Lea County, New Mexico, for a well drilled to the Drinkard formation. It is our understanding that Arco now wishes to recomplete said well in the Arrowhead Grayburg Pool. It is further our understanding that Chevron, the sole offset operator, has been notified of your intention.

Inasmuch as the location is merely six feet closer to the quarterquarter section line than the Division permits, and that Chevron has not entered an objection within the prescribed waiting period, your request will be granted.

You are therefore authorized to recomplete the State 157 "D" No. 11 Well in the Arrowhead Grayburg Pool at a location of 2123 feet from the South line and 1644 feet from the East line of said Section 12. The NW14 SE14 of said Section 12 shall be dedicated to the well.

Dear Mr. Catanach:

ARCO Oil and Gas Company respectfuly requests that Order #R-6318, granting an unorthodox oil well location in the Drinkard Pool, be administratively amended to include the Arrowhead Grayburg Pool. The well is located 2123' FSL and 1644' FEL of Section 12, Township 22 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. The NW/4 SE/4 of Section 12 is dedicated to the well, as illustrated on the attached C-102 acreage dedication plat. Due to an error in surveying, this location is six feet too close to the quarter-quarter section line. The location is, however, 507 feet from the nearest lease line. The unorthodox location was previously approved for the Drinkard Pool by Order #R-6318. The current completion in the Drinkard is producing at an uneconomical rate, and it is our intention to recomplete the well to the Arrowhead Grayburg Pool.

ARCO Oil and Gas Company believes approval of this request will be in the interest of conservation, will protect correlative rights, and will allow for a more complete recovery of Arrowhead Grayburg reserves from the subject acreage.

Chevron, the only offset operator, has been sent a copy of this request by registered mail. Thank you for your prompt consideration.

#### ORDER OF THE DIVISION

### BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on April 9, 1980, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Daniel S. Nutter.

NOW, on this <u>15th</u> day of April, 1980, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

#### FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant, ARCO Oil and Gas Company, seeks approval of an unorthodox oil well location for its State 157 "D" Well No. 11 drilled at a point 2123 feet from the South line and 1644 feet from the East line of Section 12, Township 22 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Drinkard Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

(3) That the NW/4 SE/4 of said Section 12 is to be dedicated to the well.

(4) That due to an error in surveying, the subject well was drilled six feet closer to the proration unit boundary than is permitted by the Division Rules and Regulations.

(5) That no offset operator objected to the proposed unorthodox location. -2-Case No. 6862 Order No. R-6318

(6) That approval of the subject application will afford the applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable share of the oil in the subject pool, will prevent the economic loss caused by the drilling of unnecessary wells, avoid the augmentation of risk arising from the drilling of an excessive number of wells, and will otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That an unorthodox oil well location for the Drinkard formation is hereby approved for the ARCO Oil and Gas Company State 157 "D" Well No. 11 drilled at a point 2123 feet from the South line and 1644 feet from the East line of Section 12, Township 22 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Drinkard Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

(2) That the NW/4 SE/4 of said Section 12 shall be dedicated to the above-described well.

(3) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
