

SURFACE USE PLAN  
Conoco Inc.  
Burger B-20 Nos. 2 and 3  
Warren Unit No. 78  
Sec. 20 T-20S, R-38E  
Lea County, New Mexico

The plan is to accompany "Application for Permit to Drill" the subject well. The following is a discussion of pertinent information concerning possible effect which the proposed drilling of the well may have on the environment of the well and road sites and surrounding acreage. A copy will be posted on the derrick floor so all contractors and sub-contractors will be aware of all items of this plan.

1. EXISTING ROADS

- A. The proposed well sites are:  
Burger B-20 No. 2 - 1980' FNL and 1980' FEL  
Burger B-20 No. 3 - 1980' FNL and 660' FEL  
Warren Unit No. 78 - 1980' FSL and 660' FEL
- B. Exhibit A is a portion of a New Mexico road map showing existing roads. Directions to the location are as follows: From Stanolind Road in Hobbs, travel south on NM 18 approximately 10 miles to Conoco's red, white and blue cattleguard at the Warren Unit. See Exhibit "C".
- C. Access roads are shown on Exhibits B and C.
- D. No improvement or maintenance is anticipated for the existing roads.

2. PLANNED ACCESS ROADS

- A. Width and Length: New road required will be 16' wide and varying in length. The new roads are labeled and coded on Exhibits B and C.
- B. Turnouts: One.
- C. Drainage Design: New road will have a drop of 6" from center line on each side.
- D. Culverts, Cuts, and Fills: None required.
- E. Surfacing Material: Six inches of caliche, bladed, watered and compacted.
- F. Gates, Cattleguards and Fences: None required.
- G. The proposed road is staked.
