Cultural Resources

During the course of this reconnaissance several isolated manifestations (IM) were recorded. An isolated manifestation is any artifact or concentration of cultural material separated by more than 20 m from any other manifestation. Concentrations of material are less than one artifact per square meter.

IM 1 Located in a large deflation basin; two anhydrous quartz spalls and one large, flat piece of caliche (3 ft X 2 ft X 6 in) which shows evidence of burning on one side. This may have been used as a fire shield during windy weather.

IM 2 Located in a deflation basin; a light scatter of burned- and fire-cracked caliche cobbles and two spalls of anhydrous quartz.

IM 3 One chert secondary decortication flake and small cobbles of burned- and fire-cracked caliche.
