Enclosed please find NMAS' Archaeological Clearance Report for Conoco's proposed SEMU Eumont Well No. 109, SEMU Eumont Well No. 110, SEMU Eumont Well No. 111, SEMU Eumont Well No. 112, Warren Unit Well No. 78, Burger B 20 Well No. 2 and Burger B 20 Well No. 3 and their access roads in Lea County, New Mexico.
