

cryptandrus, Sporobolus flexuosus, Cenchrus incertus, Munroa squarrosa, Andropogon glomeratus, and Paspalum distichum.

Cultural Resources

No cultural resources were recorded during this reconnaissance. Their absence can be attributed to the absence of quarryable material locally, a shortage of potable water, and a general absence of cover. On the Eunice Plain and its immediate environs, archaeological sites tend to be confined to the Monument Draw area and the escarpments bordering the San Simon Swale. Resources include flaked lithic detritus, ground stone fragments, Jornada-derived Brown Wares, rare projectile points, well-defined burned areas with high organic content, and burned- and fire-cracked caliche and sandstone.

Recommendations

NMAS recommends clearance for Conoco's proposed SEMU Eumont Well No. 112 and its access road and suggests that work-related activities proceed in accordance with company plans.
