Gentlemen:

Please find enclosed duplicate copies of Minerals, Inc.'s application for multiple completion of its Llano "3" State Com. No. 1 well located in Unit H, Section 3, T22S, R34E, Lea County, New Mexico.

Minerals, Inc. respectfully requests administrative approval of this application pursuant to Rule 112-A, II Multiple Completion (Conventional), wherein,

- (a) Order No. 5958 previously authorized a similar offset dual completion (Getty - "35" State No. 1),
- (b) (3) hydrocarbons from the oil and gas dual zones herein shall be produced through two separate parallel strings of tubing, and
- (c) both strings of tubing will be 2 3/8" O.D. with a nominal I.D. of 1.995", and
- (d) the zones will be segregated by a Baker model DB production type packer.

In addition to the application for multiple completion, you will find enclosed triplicate copies of OCD form numbers C-103, C-104, C-105, a Packer Setting Report, and a Packer Leakage Test relative to Minerals' Llano "3" State Com. No. 1 Bone Springs completion.

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
