

SURFACE USE PLAN
Conoco Inc.
Warren Unit No. 83
Sec. 29, T-20S, R-38E
Lea County, New Mexico

The plan is to accompany "Application for Permit to Drill" the subject well. The following is a discussion of pertinent information concerning possible effects which the proposed drilling of the well may have on the environment of the well, road sites, and surrounding acreage. A copy will be posted on the derrick floor so all contractors and sub-contractors will be aware of all items of this plan.

1. EXISTING ROADS

- A. The proposed well site is 2100' FSL and 1650' FWL, Section 29, T-20S, R-38E, Lea County, New Mexico.
- B. Exhibit A is a portion of a New Mexico road map showing existing roads. Directions to the location are as follows: From Hobbs, New Mexico, travel approximately 10 miles south on Highway 18 to Conoco's bicentennial cattleguard at the Warren Unit. See Exhibit C for exact directions to the location.
- C. Access roads are shown on Exhibits B and C.
- D. No improvement or maintenance is anticipated for the existing roads.

2. PLANNED ACCESS ROADS

- A. Width and Length: New road required will be 12' wide and approximately 100' long. This new road is labeled and coded on Exhibits B and C.
- B. Turnouts: Two.
- C. Drainage Design: New road will have a drop of 6" from center line on each side.
- D. Culvert, Cuts, and Fills: None required.
- E. Surfacing Material: Six inches of caliche, bladed, watered and compacted.
- F. Gates, Cattleguards and Fences: None required.
- G. The proposed road is not staked.
