suant of hunting related activities. Camping was generally limited to areas near a source of potable water.

Recommendations

NMAS recommends clearance for CONOCO's proposed Britt "B" No. 27 and its access road and <u>suggests</u> that work-related activities proceed in accordance with company plans. Clearance, of course, is granted by the Bureau of Land Management.

Terrain

The investigated area lies on an undulating plain overlain by deep aeolian deposits. Generally stabalized dunes crenulate most of the horizon. In the vicinity are occasional low hummocks and shallow deflation basins. Drainage is ultimately southward into Monument Draw. Soils are loose, non-calcareous sandy loams
