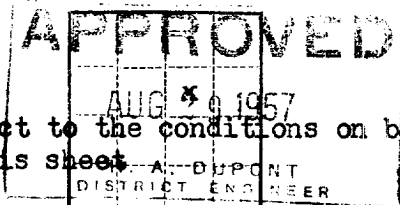

DETAILS OF WORK

It is our intention to drill a well at the above location to a total depth of approximately 9250' with rotary tools in order to continue development of McKee oil reserves and meet demands of the U. S. G. S. for further development of federal leases comprising the Warren Unit. All casing points will be cemented in accordance with approved methods of the U. S. G. S. and any other special requirements will be met and complied with.

It is planned to use the following casing pattern: 10 3/4" to be set at 250' and cemented with approximately 250 sacks, cement to be circulated. 7 5/8" to be set at 4000' and cemented with 500 sacks. 5 1/2" to be set at 9250' with 160 sacks and perforated opposite pay zone.

Approval to produce this well upon completion is also requested.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

The approval is subject to the following:

1. Cement behind the 7 5/8" casing must cover the Salt section as determined by temperature survey.
2. Cement behind the 5 1/2" casing must cover the Glorieta formation as determined by temperature survey in order to isolate from one another the potentially productive zones below the 7 5/8" casing seat.

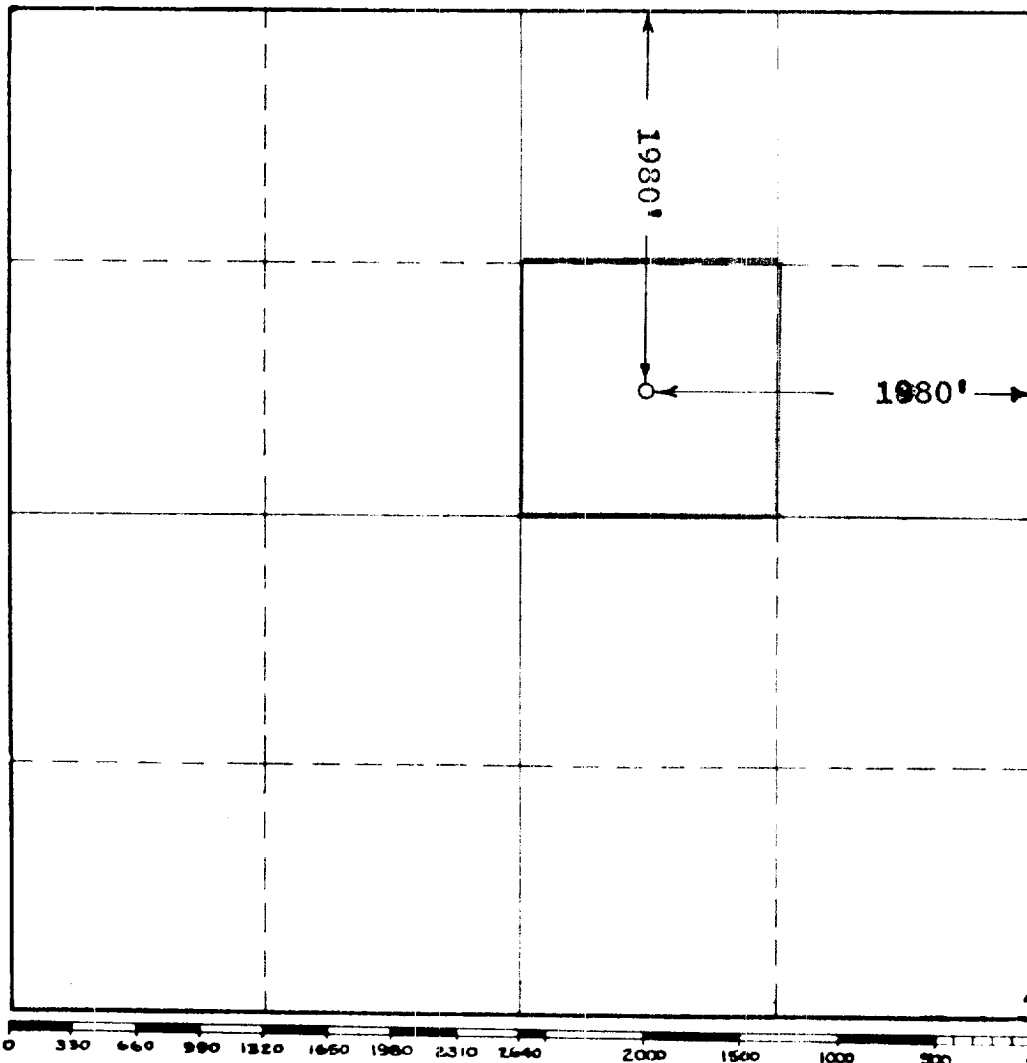
