Re: North Hardy Strawn/Production Testing

Dear Ann:

The testing that Conoco Inc. has requested on the Hardy 36 State well #26, D.M. Warren #37, Meyer B31 #5, is approved under the following conditions:

- 1. After completion of the testing, according to the schedule submitted, Conoco will reduce the flow of these wells to the allowable of 652 bbls/day.
- 2. If during the testing these wells, the production is over the allowable the over-production will be made up over the successive months to follow.
- 3. If the hearing order increases the allowable and makes the over-production retroactive then making up of over- production will not be necessary.
- 4. Conoco will notify the NMOCD District office 48 hours of any testing so an NMOCD inspector can witness the testing if time is available.
