
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Also, Raptor is hereby authorized to simultaneously dedicate Jalmat gas production from the State "A" A/C-2 Well No. 78 with the State "A" A/C-2 Wells No. 2, 27, 33, 34, 44, 46, and 47. Furthermore, Raptor is hereby permitted to produce the allowable assigned the subject 440.50-acre GPU from all eight of these wells in any proportion.

All provisions applicable to the subject GPU in Division Administrative Orders NSL-1636 (SD) (L) and NSP-1636-A (L) (SD) not in conflict with this order shall remain in full force and affect until further notice.

Jurisdiction of this matter shall be further retained for the entry of any such subsequent orders, as the Division may deem necessary.
