Dear Sir:

We refer to our original "Notice of Intention to Drill New Well," covering our No. 4 well on our State lease No. B-163 in Section 2, Township 21 South, Range 33 East, Lea County, New Mexico, dated July 25, 1933 and approved by you on August 5, 1933, and to your letter to us dated July 27, 1933 and our reply dated August 1st .

We intended originally to drill this well entirely with rotary, but we have changed our plan and now propose to drill with rotary to 1710 feet and the balance with cable tools. This changes our casing program, and in view of this, we enclose herewith, in triplicate, for your approval, a revised notice.

In connection with this well, we propose to drill a water well, which would also be located on Lot 7 of Section 2, Township 21 South, Range 33 East, to the water sand expected at somewhere between 970 feet and 1100 feet. This water well will be drilled with a rotary, and we plan to set 970 feet of 8-1/4 inch casing, properly mudded, to protect this water sand from any upper waters which may be encountered. This water well will not, of course, penetrate any of the known oil or gas horizons.
