## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Hole has been drilled to depth of 4125'. A hole full of sulphur water was encountered at depth of 4119'. We propose to plug and abandon well as follows: Drive 700 pounds of lead wool on bottom then dump 10 sacks of cement on top of lead wool. Kneck 5 1/2" casing loose and pull same back to depth of 1900', in bottom of Rustler anhydrite, then pump 20 sacks of cement down casing by plug method and spot same at depth of approximately 1900'. Pull 5 1/2" casing out of hole and spot 10 sacks of cement at bottom of 10-3/4" casing at depth of approximately 150'. Set regulation marker at surface; fill all pits and leave surface around well site in as nearly as possible the condition in which it was found.
