If changes in the above plan become advisable we will notify you before cementing or landing casing. We estimate that the first productive oil or gas sand should occur at a depth of about 3950 feet.

Additional information: We will set 13-3/8" through fresh water horizon at approximately 150' and cement with 50 sx. Will drill 150' into lime and set 7" at approximately 3550' with 100 sx. Complete with cable tools.
