Run tubing to 3950ft. Pumped in 50 Sacks of cement to the bottom with Halliburton. Raised tubing to 1900ft. Pumped in 40 Sacks of Cement and pulled 8 5/8" pipe. Put a Bridge in at 1400ft., Cemented Put a Bridge in at 900ft., filled hole to top and Cemented 4" Pipe in top.
