FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

This test has been drilled to a depth of 3957'. Sulphur water in amount of 600 feet was encountered between 3952' and 3957'. We propose to fill the hole with 8 feet of pea gravel, then drive 700 pounds of lead wool which will be capped with 50 feet of cement. We will then test this plug and if we find all water has been shut off we will fill the hole with mud. We will then come up the hole to the bottom of the 7 inch casing and knock it lose as near bottom as possible. We will then set 20 sacks of cement, with top at 1800', or 30' below the top of the Rustler Anhydrite. We will then set a cement plug of 10 sacks at the base of the 10-3/4" casing at 165' and a regulation marker in cement at the surface. We will clear the surface and leave it in as nearly the original conditon found as is possible.
