FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

In our Notice of Intention to Drill, filed October 23, 1948, we stated our intention of cementing 5" casing at a depth of 3600'. We have found it advisable to change this plan and cement said casing at depth of 2000 feet; well into the Salt section. We have, therefore, cemented this string of casing at depth of 2000 feet with 50 sacks. Plug was pumped down late on November 3, 1948. We will allow cement a minimum set time of 72 hours before drilling plug with cable tools and testing pipe for satisfactory water shut off.

Total depth of hole at time 7" casing was cemented was 3610'
