Dump 5 sacks of cement in bottom to shut off a little gas at 3897 to 3903. Fill hole to bottom of 8" pipe set at 1272. Knock off 8" pipe, fill with mud to top of surface and set 4" pipe in cement for marker

Bridge and cement plug of 10 sax cement at 1410'. Fill with mud to 350'. Set bridge and cement plug of 10 sax cement. Fill with mud to surface and set regulation marker. Extend 4' above surface.
