17. Describe Proposed or Completed Operations (Clearly state all pertinent details, and give pertinent dates, including estimated date of starting any proposed work) SEE RULE 1103.

April 10, 1979 set 65 sx. class C cement plug with tubing at 3672'. NMOCC witness plug. OK shot casing at 1600'. Ran 2 3/8" tubing with tension packer at 1459'. Could not break formation. Left pressure on well. Bled off 6 days later. In June 1979 pressured on casing (shot at 1600'). Was able to pump into well at less than 100 PSI. The well is ready to set cement plug (35 sx.) at 1600'.

8-27-79 Casing pullers & pluggers expect to get to plugging well soon after Aug. 1, 1979.

Respectfully request a 60 day extension from 8-31-79 for completion of P & A subject well.
