## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

This well was drilled to a total depth of 3903' in line. Ran 125-1/3 jts of 5 1/2" OD casing 3900.7' set at 3902.7' and cemented with 400 sax. The plug was down 9:50 P.M. 1-12-51. Cement was allowed to set 48 hours, plug drilled out, hole bailed dry and after 2 hours drilling was resumed when no water entered the hole.
