DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At a total depth of 210' we ran and cemented 187' of 10", 40# casing, with 100 sacks of cement. The Halliburton method was used and the cement was circulated to the surface. The cement set from June 11, to June 18, and when tools (rotary) were run into the hole, 18' of hard cement was drilled. Drilling ahead was resumed and it appears that a satisfactory cement job and water shut-off was obtained.
