## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

We ran 187' of 10", 40# casing and cemented it with 100 sacks of cement by Halliburton. The cement circulated to the surface. The fresh water sand was penetrated and the shoe of the casing is in red shale below the water sand. We propose to allow the cement to set for at least 72 hours and then to drill ahead with rotary tools as outlined in form #C-101. This casing was run and cemented June 11, the plug was stopped about 15' off bottom at 3:00 P.M.
