3/26/59 - hole full of rotary mud. Ran tubing to 2200 and spotted 20 sacks cement from 2200 to 2100 in 7" OD Casing at top of salt..

3/27/59 - washed water sand at 100-120 feet with clear water. Spotted 50 sack plug at 130-80 feet in open hole and bottom of 8-5/8" casing to hold fresh water in its bed.

Ran 5 sack plug in top of 8-5/8" casing, screwed in marker and ran cement around top.

Cleaned location and left approximately as found.
